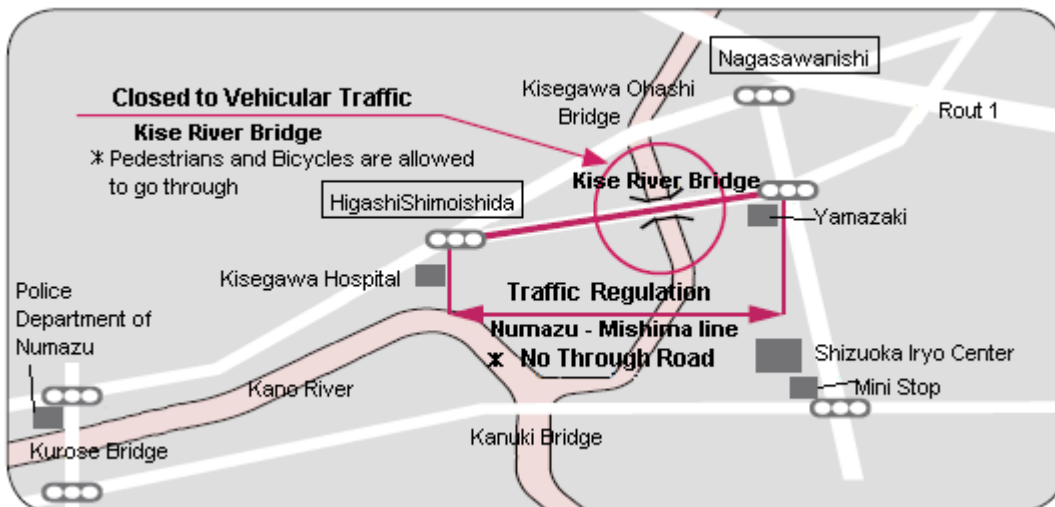

Let's Promote Eco-friendly Life by Shopping at Smile Shops!

Numazu City is promoting the reduction and recycling of garbage under the slogan of "Don't make nor throw away garbage as consumers. Don't sell nor buy the things which are sure to become garbage as sellers." 'The Smile Shop System,' which started in 2000, is one of those challenges. Smile Shops are becoming familiar as eco-friendly shops in our lives.

◆What is 'a Smile Shop'?

When a store tries to carry out more than 3 items out of the following 8 goals, Numazu City authorizes the store as a Smile Shop. 57 stores are authorized as of Sep. 30. Among them, 17 stores, which have been authorized as a smile shop and carried out more than 5 items (including ⑤ and ⑧) for two years, were awarded the Gold Award.

8 goals

Simple wrapping

Encouraging customers to bring shopping bags with them

Selling refills, reusable containers, or recycled goods(goods with eco-mark or green mark)

Selling by measure, Not selling in packages

Collecting recyclable materials like Styrofoam and recycling them

Carrying out repair services

Using recycled paper for leaflets, wrapping paper, toilet paper in the store, copy paper, etc.

Planning and carrying out the store's own plan for garbage reduction and recycling

◆What you should do for eco-friendly shopping

A Smile Shop System is a challenge which the sellers' side is working on. We want you, the consumers' side, to make use of smile shops and try to do eco-friendly shopping.

Don't take plastic bags. Plastic bags, even if they are city-approved bags, can be a waste if there are too many.

Refuse over wrapping.

Try to buy goods with an eco-mark or refillable goods.

Rinse the empty plastic trays or milk cartons before bringing them to collection boxes.

Revising a System of Child Allowance(Kodomo Teate)

Child Allowance has been provided since 2010. This allowance will be revised from Oct., and it will be provided based on the new revised system.

Q: Who can apply for it?

Child allowance is provided to the person who mainly takes care of children aged 0 to 15, who were born after April in 1996. The necessary requirement is that the children should live in Japan, except those who are studying abroad. There is no limitation on income.

*If you are filing for divorce and living separately with your partner, child allowance is provided to the person who is living with the children. You need to submit its certificate.

*If a family member who mainly makes a living in the house has been working in another city, please do the procedure in the city.

*If you have children living in a home, Child Allowance is provided to the home.




Q: Who needs to do the Child Allowance procedure?

Even though you have already received Child Allowance, you need to apply for it again. Numazu city will send you an application form and an information letter at the end of Oct, so please submit it. If you move to Numazu city or to another city after Oct., please do the procedure immediately. If a new baby will be born after Oct., please do it so as well. Child Allowance will not be paid if you are late in applying.

*After you apply to receive Child Allowance, it is paid from the following month. As a special case, however, you can receive it if your child already falls under its provision requirement on Oct.1. Please do the procedure at the city hall by Mar. 31, 2012. If you do so, you can receive the total from Oct.

*Numazu city will inform you later about the Child Allowance from Apr.

Child Allowance will be provided on Oct. 13(Thu).

Child Allowance, which is worth of 4 months (from June to Sep.) will be provided soon. If you applied for it after July, we will provide its total from the month you applied to September.
