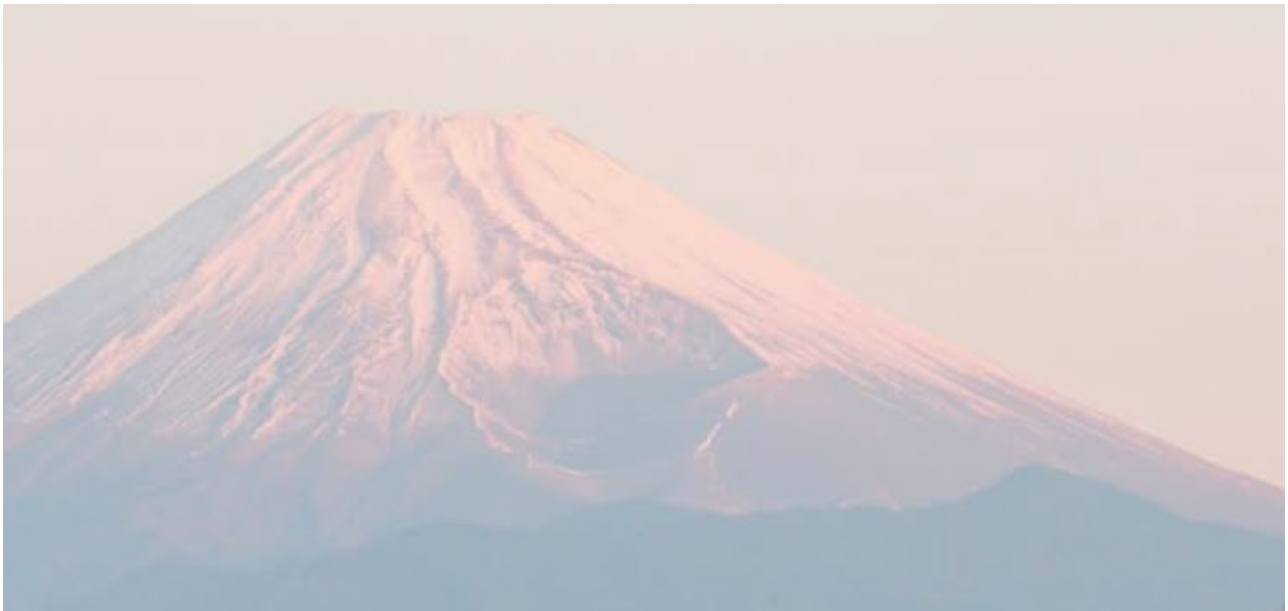

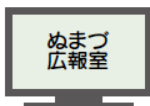

= Coming-of-age means you are legally responsible for everything you do, so be careful when you sign a contract =

Coming-of-Age Day for 2014 has come. Those who have turned twenty are greatly different from those underage in that they are recognized as an adult in society and in that they legally have to be responsible for what they do, which is the same when they sign a contract. In Japan, even though a person who is underage has signed a contract, if it was signed without his/her parents' consent, it is basically possible to invalidate the contract by claiming that it is an "Infant's contract" and is able to be cancelled. However, just after the moment people have reached twenty, they are no longer protected by this system. Signing a contract is an "act of law," which brings responsibility. Please make sure to be very careful when you sign a contract so that you won't get involved in any trouble. If there is any chance of trouble, please contact the Consumers' Life Center to ask for help.

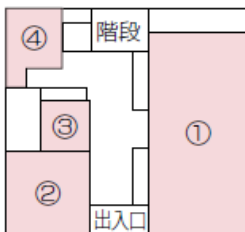

Outline of the facility

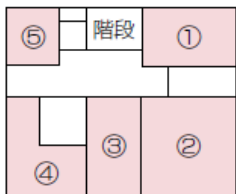
