City Government is Promoting the Project to Conserve Beautiful Landscapes

Each of us, as one of the citizens of Numazu city, should play an important role of protecting our city's wonderful landscapes and passing them down to future generations. The city government has been promoting the Aesthetic Town Renovation, one of whose examples is the Numazu City Scenery Plan instituted in 2010.

☆Please Follow the Rules for Outdoor Advertising☆


Sign boards, advertising towers or pillars, posters, standing billboards, banners, advertisement which is painted or attached on the walls of buildings or structures; these things are all considered as Outdoor Advertising Objects.

◆ New standards for permission to display outdoor advertisements under the Municipal Ordinance on Outdoor Advertisement will come into operation as of Apr. 1.

Numazu city government has newly established the ordinance adapted to the actual circumstances of this city in order to regulate outdoor advertisements and lead them to more appropriate ones, aiming at conserving the beautiful landscapes. Details about "restricted areas", "respective rules", and others should be checked and confirmed because the new municipal ordinance is partly different from the existing Prefectural Ordinance on Outdoor Advertisement. Transition period is three years; outdoor advertising objects meeting the present standards will have to be changed into the ones that should meet the new standards under the new ordinance.

◆Charge for service are to be reexamined.

Application fee for the permission to display outdoor advertising objects is going to be revised as of Apr. 1.



There are many different kinds of outdoor advertising objects in town.

◆Don't fail to make applications for permission to display outdoor advertisements.

When you want to display an outdoor advertising object, you need to get the permission according to its necessary space, because there are respectively different restrictions based on where to place it or what kind of object it is. So please make



sure to consult with the city on whether you need to get the permission when you want to place outdoor advertising objects for newly constructed offices or stores. Also please check whether there are any outdoor advertising objects without permission among the existing ones.

☆Areas Around Numazu Port is to be designated as the "Priority Zone for Beautiful Landscapes" on Apr. 1



In order to protect and conserve the scenery around Numazu Port, which is bustling with many visitors, the city government will make every effort with a view to building more fascinating landscapes while conserving the scene of a fish market.

◆What is "Priority Zone for Beautiful Landscapes"?



It is the area whose landscapes are going to be protected and improved, based on the newly established rules to promote the city's landscape policy. At present, the area around Numazu Station and the area of *Hakuin-no-michi* are designated as "Priority Zone for Beautiful Landscapes," and the city is going to designate two more areas in the near future, one of which is the area around *Hara* station,

and the other is the area around Heda Port.

◆If designated as "Priority Zone for Beautiful Landscapes"?

When you construct a new building, renovate an old one, or remodel the outside of a building, you will have to give notice of its external appearance or outside view to the city.
