Don't Forget to Register When You Move!

The Procedures You Should Go through When Moving

A lot of people are planning to move because of a new job or going on to college in the spring. We will introduce the necessary steps to take when moving.

Register your change of address within 14 days when moving

The contents will be registered on the Basic Resident Registration Card and become valuable data which proves your address.

Necessary items when you apply for the following certificates

* A copy of your family register (for all or a member) Document of identification (A Power of Attorney (<i>Ininjo</i>)) is necessary to submit when you are not a lineal relative.)	* A copy of resident card Document of identification (A Power of Attorney is necessary to submit when you aren't a member of the same household.)
* A seal registration certificate Your seal registration or your citizen's card that has the seal registration (You can't get a seal registration certificate only with your registered seal.)	

***The registration of moving in or out including birth and death is obligated by the law.**



We ask you for confirmation of your identity

In order to prevent false registration by another person, we check each person who comes to register the change of address (moving in or out), or family register (affiliation, marriage, divorce, adoption of child, dissolution). So please present some documents which identify you at the time of registration. When a deputy submits the registration, the letter of attorney is necessary.

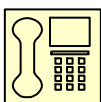

Automatic Issuance Machine Services(at night or on weekends)

It is necessary for you to have a Numazu Shimin Card to use an Automatic Machine. You can ask for issuance of a Shimin Card(change over) and PIN(personal identification number) at the Resident Registration Division or each branch office. The registration of PIN must be done only by yourself. You must bring your photo ID Card issued by the government or other public offices (a driver's license or a passport, etc.) with you.

The Expense of Rubella Vaccine and MR (Measles-Rubella vaccine) will be partly subsidized.

A woman infected by the rubella virus during pregnancy may give birth to a baby with congenital defects. We subsidize part of the expense for vaccination to the following people when they get it from July 1 (Mon), 2013 to Mar. 31 (Mon) in 2014.

Applicants: (1) Family members living with a woman who is pregnant
(2) A woman who plans or hopes to get pregnant

*Only for a person living in Numazu, who has never had Rubella and who has never received Rubella or MR vaccine.

Amount of subsidy: Rubella Vaccine = 4,000 yen,

MR vaccine (Measles-Rubella vaccine) = 5,000 yen

Deadline: Apr. 8 (Tue) *Please contact us or visit the website for details.

*Please apply for it after you get vaccinated at hospital.



Recruiting Volunteer Nurse at Disaster First-aid Stations

Do you know about Pedestrian-Vehicle Separated Signals?

Recently pedestrian-vehicle separated signals have been installed to prevent car-pedestrian accident on a pedestrian crossing. Please obey traffic rules and follow the signals at pedestrian crossings when crossing at an intersection.

What is Pedestrian-Vehicle Separated Signals?

Pedestrian-vehicle separated signal is a form of traffic control in which all oncoming traffic is stopped on the red light, allowing pedestrians to cross the road on the green light. This type of traffic light is installed at intersections with a lot of pedestrians. Numazu city adopts “**Pedestrian signal indication system**” and “**Pedestrian scramble**” from four types of pedestrian-vehicle separated signals in consideration of width and the shape of intersection. There are nine pedestrian-vehicle separated signals installed in Numazu city as of February 2014.

■ Pedestrian Signal Indication System



There are signs of pedestrian-vehicle separated system (*Hosyabunri-shiki*) on traffic lights.

Pedestrians are not allowed to cross diagonally.

■ Pedestrian Scramble



There are signs of scramble system on traffic lights.

There are diagonal crossing markings on pavement.

Pedestrians are allowed to cross in any direction.

*Group vaccination is held rain or shine. *Do not come to the site by car.

*If your dog is too nervous or fearful and easily agitated, you'd better take your dog to an animal hospital rather than group vaccination site.

**Dogs that can not receive rabies vaccinations: a puppy less than three months, a dog which received another vaccination within a month, a pregnant dog and/or lactating, a dog under treatment. If you have concerns about your dog's health condition, consult with your veterinarian before your dog receives the vaccination.

Purification in the Sea: The traditional event in the coldest season



It is an annual event for health and a big crop in mid-January. “*Kamio*,” men who serve gods, from Yanagihara Shrine and Oh-asa Shrine carry portable shrines to the beach, have a ceremony together and go into the water with the shrines. The event started in

Edo period, but stopped during World War II. It was revived in 2002. It is held in Kohama Beach in Ushibuse Park. *Kamio* are selected from men who were born in years with the same sign of the Chinese zodiac as the current year, 20-year-old men and men of the unfortunate ages.
