Temporary Welfare Benefit

The consumption tax has been raised to 8% from this April. As a tentative and temporary measure to reduce the tax burden of low-income earners, 'temporary welfare benefit' is to be paid. Beneficiary: People whom city tax for the fiscal year 2014 is not to be imposed on (taxation on per capita basis)

*The following cases are not eligible; A person who fends for the low-income earner needs to pay tax, or the low-income earner is a beneficiary of Welfare Benefit System.

- Amount of benefit: 10,000 yen per person (5,000 yen is added if the person is a beneficiary of Basic Pension for the Elderly, or Child-Care Allowance.)
- *Details about the application period or the application procedures should be informed of in Newsletters or other as soon as they get decided.

Special Exception System for Students on Payment of National Pension Premium

There is a moratorium system on payment of national pension premium for the students who have difficulty paying the premium. Making use of this system is strongly recommended so as to receive an adequate pension in the future.

Applicants: Students whose annual income in the previous year is under 1,180,000 yen What to bring: personal seal, pension certificate, student identification card or student

- registration certificate, and something that certifies the income of the previous year if any. (Certificate of tax deducted)
- Where to apply: Resident Registration Division (City Hall 1F) or Citizens Information Office for each area
- *Application procedure for this system is required every fiscal year.

*This system applies to the period of 2 years and 1 month before the time of application.

Take the Procedure for Joining or Leaving National Health Insurance

April is the time of getting employment or company transfer. The following people need to take procedures for joining or leaving National Health Insurance; Those who have joined or left Social Insurance and those who have moved into or out of the city. Please take procedures as soon as possible at Resident Registration Division (City Hall 1F) or Citizens Information Office at each area.

Numazu City Subsidy System for the Cost of Specific Fertility Treatment

City government partly finances the cost related with the specific fertility treatment for the first and the second child; the amount of grant money aided by the Prefectural government should be deducted from the total cost.

Subsidy: Upper limit 50,000 yen for one medical treatment

Number of times: 2 times a year (3 times a year for the first year to start the treatment)

(The period one can get the subsidy is 5 years in all.)

Applicants: Married couples who satisfy all of the following requirements

- ① Couples who got medical treatment for external fertilization or micro-fertilization at the designated medical institutions.
- ② Couples who married on census registration and one of whom has resident registration in Numazu city for over one year.
- ③ Couples whose total income of the previous year was less than 7,300,000 yen. (When they apply for the subsidy during the period from January to May, the total income of the year before the last should be less than 7,300,000 yen.)

How to apply: Make an application to Health Center directly; within the fiscal year which the completion day of the treatment is in. (However, in the case that the treatment was completed during the period from January to March, applications must be made within 90 days after the completion day of treatment.)

Documents to be submitted:

- 1 Application form for the subsidy payment for the cost of specific fertility treatment
- 2 Certification form of the consultation for specific fertility treatment
- ③ Accounting form of the cost of specific fertility treatment
- ④ Receipts
- 5 Certification form of all items on consensus registration
- 6 Documents that can show proof of the previous-year income of the couple
- ⑦ Bank book
- 8 Seal

XIn the case that the total cost of the treatment was under 200,000 yen and the subsidy from the prefectural government has already been paid, documents that can prove the amount of its subsidy should be necessary.

*What is photochemical oxidant?

It is a pollutant generated by the chemical reaction when gas exhausted from smoke of factories or auto fumes bathe the rays of the sun. The photochemical oxidant is easy to get highly concentrated when the sun is strong, the temperature is high and the wind is slight.

*When photochemical smog warning or advisory is announced,

You should stay indoors as much possible as you can, and close the windows.

When your eyes irritated, clean them and gargle when you have a sore throat.

*May 1(Thu) ~ Sep. 30(Tue) is Close Monitoring Period of Photochemical Oxidant.

Photochemical oxidant is easy to be generated during this season.

We keep a close eye in order to prevent damage caused by photochemical pollution.




