Once a big earthquake occurs, collapsed houses or fallen concrete block walls might take many lives. In order to save lives and secure evacuation routes, we advise you to repair concrete block walls and reinforce your houses

Subsidy for removal or repair of concrete block walls

Subsidy for quakeproofing wooden houses



We will subsidize a part of the seismic retrofitting plan or reinforcement cost for the wooden houses built before May 31, 1981.

The procedure

- ① Free diagnosis by an expert of earthquake resistance testing
- ② Drawing the seismic retrofitting plan Two-thirds of the planning cost (upper limit 96,000 yen) will be subsidized.

(In case of a family composed only of 65 year-old people or older, the upper limit is 144,000 yen.)





Numazu's 100 Treasure Troves #27



Hama-no-Kannon-san; Goddess of Mercy in Hase-dera Temple

The temple, Hase-dera, is located near Senbon Beach. Its nickname is Hama-no-Kannon-san. It was built in the Heian Period (794 \sim 1868). Kannon-dai-mandala is annually open to the public in April. Mandala is a drawing of the god or the goddess. Mandala drawn on a sail have been dedicated to the temple praying for safety of voyage since the Edo Period. Last April a lot of people enjoyed the gorgeous (30 meters x 13 meters) sail mandala drawn in the Showa Era.



Nearby Numazu's Treasure Troves

1 Sembon-matsubara:

It literally means 1,000 pine trees. It is a good walking course along the coast.

2 Jamatrsu-ryokudo:

A walking course along the used railway track between Numazu station and Numazu port

3 Wakayama Bokusui Memorial Museum:

The famous poet's literature works and memorabilia are displayed.
