■What is "Action Plan against Earthquakes and Tsunami"?

Numazu City made "the Action Plan against Earthquakes and Tsunami" based on the 4th seismic damage assumption by Shizuoka prefectural government. In order to reduce damage, it has plans and measures for 3 years and action goals for 5-10 years.

■ 5 mainstays and their measures

1 Measures according to degree of hazard each area

Eliminating areas where evacuation is difficult, preparing the evacuation board etc.

2 To secure escape time from tsunami.

Promoting earthquake-proofing buildings and houses, removing fragile block walls, etc.

3 Preparation for disaster reduction

Promoting education for disaster prevention, upgrading and strengthening emergency drill, promoting emergency goods' stockpiling, etc.

4 Strengthening of town disaster prevention

Maintaining escape routes, managing urgent transportation routes, promoting earthquake-proofing of infrastructures, etc.

5 Speedy restoration and recovery

Strengthening functions of medical aid, rescue system and management of evacuation shelters, supporting sufferers' lives in evacuation sites.

■Our effort in the future

We promote our project based on the action plan, collaborating with citizens and voluntary disaster prevention groups. As we check how the project progresses, we reevaluate its aims or measures every three years. About details, please look at the website of Numazu City.

◆If You Have National Health Insurance, "Have You Declared Your Income Yet?"

People who didn't have any income or don't need any declaration of their income under the tax law (e.g. people who only have tax-free pension such as survivor's pension or disability pension) can reduce their insurance premium by the declaration. Please contact us before June 20 (Fri).

If people have already completed the declaration of their income or have received the national or employee's pension, or their employers submitted their payment reports, they don't need to declare their income.

100 Numazu's Treasure Troves No. 28 Delicacy of Suruga Bay—Deep Sea Fish Food

Suruga Bay is 2,500 meters deep, known as the deepest in Japan.

By trawling off the coast of Heda, a variety of kinds of deep sea fish are caught from the 300 meters deep and landed on Heda and Numazu Harbor. Fishermen used to eat these deep sea fish in their daily lives. The light flavor of deep fish, however, is getting popular and now they are served at hotels and restaurants around Heda and Numazu Harbor. As deep sea fish has evolved so that they can survive in the deep sea, they have characteristic figures like big eyes. People can enjoy not only eating but also looking at unique figures.

Suruga Bay Deep Sea Creature Museum (2710-1 Heda)



About 300 kinds of samples of unique deep sea fish and creatures, such as *rabuka* (a frilled shark called living fossil) are displayed in the museum.

Characteristic Deep Sea Fish at Suruga Bay

Geho (right): Geho has a pointed head and big eyes. We can enjoy Sashimi (sliced raw fish), and boiled one is also good.

Torobocchi (center): *Torobocchi* live 400 meters deep in the sea. They are made into *karaage* (deep-frying without any flour coating) and *hanpen*(a cake of ground fish combined with starch and steamed)

Takaashi gani (Japanese Giant Spider Crab)(left): *Takaashigani* is the largest crab in the world. Widening the legs, it becomes about as long as 3 meters. We can eat after boiling.
