Prevention of food poisoning

It is important to keep yourself from suffering from food poisoning during summer. Food poisoning is caused when bacteria and viruses adhere to hands or food such as meat and fish, and

go into the body. There are three principles which are 'Don't put,' 'Don't increase,' and 'Sterilize' bacteria and viruses to prevent food poisoning during summer. You can prevent it at home in the following ways.

1 Make sure of the "best before" date, and eat all of the food so there are no leftovers.

2 Keep the temperature in a refrigerator under 10 $^\circ$ C and a freezer under $-15 ^\circ$ C.

- ③ Wash your hands with soap before you start cooking.
- ④ Wash cookware, dishcloths and sponge carefully and dry them well.

Symptoms of diarrhea and vomiting due to food poisoning are a defense reaction of the body trying to eliminate the causative agent. It's important to consult a doctor as soon as possible without taking medicine such as anti-diarrhea which is commercially available.

Operational Change of "Neighboring School Selection System"

The city government is to launch a new manner of operation of "Neighboring School Selection System" after the next school year 2015. From the view point of disaster prevention, there have been a lot of concerns about the extensively wide commuting area, which is beyond the original commuting distance. Also school children and students who commute from the extensive area have difficulty participating in their own regional activities. Because of those reasons, the operation of the system is to be changed as follows;

♦ Requirements for the Selection of Neighboring Schools

The direct distance from home to the neighboring school of your choice must be shorter than that from home to the designated school in your habitation area. And the distance from home to the neighboring elementary school of your choice needs to be within 2 km, and that to the junior high school needs to be within 2.5 km.

*Transitional measures should be conducted in the following cases

- * school children who are attending the neighboring elementary school and want to go on to the junior high school in the same school area of their elementary school
- [†] children whose older sisters or brothers are attending the neighboring school and want to enter the same school as their siblings
