<u>Kodomo Iryo Jyukyusha-sho</u> (Certificate of Medical Allowance for Children) will be renewed

We will send a new *Iryohi Jukyusha-sho* to a parent whose child is under high school age. From Oct. 1 (Wed), when your child goes to see a doctor, please submit it with their health insurance certificate. If you haven't received the certificate yet for some reasons such as move-in or newborn, please come to Health Center or Heda Health Center with their health insurance certificate and seal.

Chicken Pox Vaccination

To whom: ① Children over 1 year old and under 3 years old

② Children over 3 years old and under 5 years old (They need to be registered their residency in Numazu city.)



The number of vaccination:

- ① Two shots (We recommend children to receive the second shot within 6 to 12 months of the first vaccination date. The minimum interval between shots is 3 months.)
- ② One shot (Receive the vaccination from Oct. 1(Wed) to Mar. 31(Tue), 2015)

Notes:

- ① Children who have received one chicken pox vaccination can receive the second shot. (If children have received two shots of vaccination, they can't receive the vaccination.)
- ② Children who have received one chicken pox vaccination can't receive the vaccination. We will send a ticket for vaccinations to eligible person.
