Yosakoi dance festival was originally started in Kochi city in August 1954 and Numazu city has arranged it into the Numazu style. There will be about 3,000 participants this year from within and without Numazu city. There are two basic rules in Yosakoi Dance: dancers have Naruko castanets in their hands and the music has Yosakoi Naruko Odori in it. The dance has changed with the times, so the dancers wear unique costumes and hair, and the style of music is arranged in different ways such as jazz, hip-hop, and even Japanese dancing tune. We are aiming to make a city where people with and without disabilities understand and support each other to live with a smile in ways they like. In this city, about 9,500 of the challenged are living, and more than 160 people get Identification Booklet for the disabled newly each year. Anyone can experience physical or mental disabilities by sickness or injury. This can happen to us, too. There are the challenged who work in employment support centers for the people with disabilities (*Fukushi Jigyosho*) or general companies, taking advantage of the ability and personality of the person. In this special topic, we are going to introduce the workplaces where the challenged work. In this opportunity, let's think about what we can do to live with the challenged. # Increase the Motivation and Social Involvement of Challenged People

A report from Fukushi Jigyosho

Fukushi Jigyosho are one of the workplaces where challenged people work. In these places, people who have difficulties finding a job at private companies or want to participate in job training do their job such as making original bread, doing cleaning service, recycling service and other operations from private companies. The sales lead to their wage for their labor, which motivates them to work and promote their independence and social involvement.



# \*Shuro Keizoku Shien Jigyosho (Job Assistance Office for the challenged): Bakery Suzuran at Takazawa-cho

In "Suzuran" bakery, challenged people make bread from scratch, package and sell them on their own. Their bread is not only sold at a bakery but also delivered to about 10 companies including the City Hospital and is bought and liked by many people.

# \*Shuro Keizoku Shien Jigyosho (Job Assistance Office for the challenged): Café Crayon at Takazawa-cho

We have easy access to an employment support center for the challenged "Café Crayon." Challenged people work there as waiting or cooking staffs, learning how to use their appropriate language and dress appropriately in working lives.

# Develop a Better Understanding of Challenged Workers

Employment in general private companies is an important part of the social involvement of challenged people. Last year, the designated employment rate of persons with disabilities in general private companies rose from 1.8% to 2.0%. However, the actual employment rate in Shizuoka Prefecture is 1.72% (as of September, 2013), which means we fail to satisfy the legal employment rate. What can we do to achieve the legal employment rate?

We feature some companies with high actual employment rates.

#### \*Tokai Kometto (at Nishimakado)

Tokai Komette, which runs a dry-cleaning business, hires 6 challenged people out of 40 employees. They started to employ challenged people about ten years ago. They decided on the employment to increase work opportunity for challenged people. Challenged workers here used to go through job training at *Fukushi Jigyosho*. Now they work on their own ground. Some workers carry lots of clothes and others concentrate on one thing for a long time.

# \*Special Elderly Nursing Home "Miharuno Oka Ukishima (at Hiranuma)"

Miharuno Oka Ukishima hires 2 challenged people out of 98 employees. For example, Ms. Asai is in charge of cleaning rooms and floors. Her co-worker Ms. Iida evaluates her dedication to her work.

# What Can We do in order to Realize a Society where People With or Without Disabilities Help Each Other?

The city aims to realize a society where challenged people participate in various kinds of activities as members of society in the same way of as other ordinary citizens. How can we support challenged people?

# Buy their Original Products and Support Them! A shop selling original products: PINE

On the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of City Hall, there is a shop "PINE," which sells food or products made by challenged people. This shop is operated by "Numazu-shi no Shogaisha Fuskushino Jujitsuo Kangaeru Kai (association to promote welfare service for people with disabilities) in order to promote social involvement of challenged people. They sell their original products by themselves and communicate with other citizens.

# Information ~~Keep the Due Date of Municipal Tax Payment~~

Shizuoka Pref. has decreed Nov. and Dec. as Tax Delinquency Collection Awareness Months. Not only does tax delinquency bring a sense of unfairness to many people who pay taxes on time, but also makes the local government finances much worse, which can affect the provision of local public service.

If You Don't Pay Your Municipal Tax by the Due Date: If you don't pay your municipal tax by the due date, a delinquent penalty will be charged and you will receive a delinquent tax notice. If the tax remains unpaid without any consultation with the department, the department will proceed to collect your tax debt by using several different enforcement methods. As shown in the following flowchart, the department first inspects all your properties and then forecloses and sells them to collect your unpaid tax.

To Resolve the Overdue Payments: Under the authorities of the Local Tax Act, the department may collect the delinquent municipal tax debt by foreclosing the properties of delinquent taxpayers if their delinquent taxes aren't paid after the delinquent tax notice is issued.

What to Do If You Can't Pay Your Tax: If you can't pay your tax on time due to inevitable reasons such as diseases, disasters, unemployment or financial trouble in a company, please consult us as soon as possible. We'll make a payment plan considering your situation.

# <The Flowchart of Tax Delinquency Collection Process>

#### A Tax Delinquency Notice Is Sent to the Delinquent Taxpayers

A tax delinquency notice is sent to the delinquent tax payers within 20 days after the due date. They have to pay another 50 yen for the issuance of a tax delinquency notice.

# The Delinquent Taxpayer's Property Is Inspected

If the tax remains unpaid after the notice is sent, the property of the delinquent taxpayer's is inspected. Information about the delinquent taxpayer's property is collected from interviews, inspection and searches in his/her work places, banks, insurance companies or business partners.

# The Delinquent Taxpayer's Property Found by Inspection Is Foreclosed

The property of the delinquent taxpayers is foreclosed, including claims (deposits and savings, salary, life insurance, account receivables, rents), real estate, vehicles and personal assets.

\*By due process of the law, the department may take enforcement action to collect unpaid tax. The law provides that the department can inspect and foreclose the property of a delinquent taxpayer without giving him/her notice in advance.

# The Foreclosed Property Is Sold By Public Auction

The foreclosed property is sold by public auction. Money gained by the auction is provided for the unpaid tax debt (municipal tax, delinquency tax etc.).
