#### Necessary items when you apply for the following certificates

# \*A copy of your family register (for all or a member) Document of identification (A Power of Attorney (*Ininjo*)) is necessary to submit when you are not a lineal relative.)

#### \* A copy of resident card

Document of identification (A Power of Attorney is necessary to submit when you aren't a member of the same household.)

#### \* A seal registration certificate

Your seal registration or your citizen's card that has the seal registration (You can't get a seal registration certificate only with your registered seal.)

#### We ask you for confirmation of your identity

In order to prevent false registration by another person, we check each person who comes to register the change of address (moving in or out), or family register (affiliation, marriage, divorce, adoption of child, dissolution). So please present some documents which identify you at the time of registration. When a deputy submits the registration, the letter of attorney is necessary.

#### Numazu Newsletters Issue 1,500!

Numazu Newsletters, starting in 1950, have given citizens lots of information about municipal administration and daily lives for 64 years. Now we have reached issue 1,500!

Let's see the advances in Numazu newsletters from different angles.

#### Issue 1 (It was issued on May 1, 1950.)

The feature on the first issue was the mayor's remark about the issue of Numazu Newsletters and the city budget. In those days, the Numazu newsletters were circulated among households in their neighborhood, though they are now given to all the households in Numazu.



#### **Issue 1000** (It was issued on Aug. 15, 1993.)

According to a questionnaire on Numazu Newsletter, what article interested readers most was No.1 =Emergency Hospitals, No. 2 =Feature Articles, No. 3 =Event Information.

#### The latest issue reached 83,700 copies

Numazu newsletters started to be given to all the households in Numazu in 1953, when we issued 22,000 copies. It shows that the number of households in Numazu has increased for more than sixty years.

87.5 % of the citizens answered that they get information about municipal administration mostly from Numazu newsletters, according to a questionnaire. This shows that Numazu newsletters have a very important role in municipal administration.

Dog owners have to register their dogs aged three months and over once in their lifetime, and have them vaccinated against rabies once a year. Please have your dogs vaccinated at the animal hospitals or designated vaccination sites listed below.

Things to bring: Dog vaccination book, vaccination notice postcard Fee: (differs from hospital to hospital) +550 yen (for rabies vaccination tag)

\*In case of a new dog, registration fee is required separately. (3,000 yen)

Rabies Vaccination Certificate to the Clean Center Management Division or Environmental Policy Division in City Hall, and get a rabies vaccination tag. (Fee: 550 yen)

<sup>\*\*</sup>Dogs that can not receive rabies vaccinations: a puppy less than three months, a dog which received another vaccination within a month, a pregnant dog and/or lactating, a dog under treatment. If you have concerns about your dog's health condition, consult with your veterinarian before your dog receives the vaccination.




