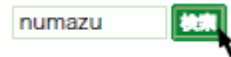

***Subsidy system for the cost of specific fertility treatments**

Numazu City finances the cost of the specific fertility treatment including general and male fertility treatment, and that of the female fertility treatment.

For: Married couples who satisfy all of the following requirements

- ① married couples who have resident registration in this city
- ② couples whose total income of the previous year was less than 7,300,000 yen
- ③ the age of the wife who started the treatment was under 43

Subsidy: Half of the total medical treatment cost including health insurance treatment and upper limit 300,000 yen a year for each couple

Period of subsidy: five years in aggregate

How to apply: Submit the necessary forms to the Health Center.

*You can get the forms at Health Center or download them from the City website.

***Backup benefit for those with specific *nanbyo*(intractable disease) [for the first half year]**

Numazu City provides backup benefits for those who have their subsidy recipient certificate of *Tokutei iryo-hi* (specific nanbyo medical treatment) issued by Shizuoka Prefecture. The following items need to be mentioned in the certificate: he/she has been recognized, he/she has a serious condition, he/she is dependents on an artificial respirator and it is 低 I or 低 II. If you are suitable for this application, please come to Health Center.

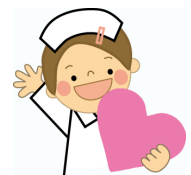
