

Please Make thorough Preparation against Earthquakes by Using Subsidy System

Once a big earthquake occurs, collapsed houses or fallen concrete block walls might take many lives. In order to save lives and secure evacuation routes, we advise you to repair concrete block walls and reinforce your houses.

Subsidy for quakeproofing wooden houses



We will subsidize a part of the seismic retrofitting plan or reinforcement cost for the wooden houses built before May 31, 1981.

The procedure

① Free diagnosis by an expert of earthquake resistance testing

② Drawing the seismic retrofitting plan, 96,000 yen will be subsidized.

(In case of a family composed only of 65 year-old people or older, the subsidy is 144,000 yen.)

③ If you quakeproof your house, 500,000 yen will be subsided.

(In case of a family composed only of 65 year-old people or older, the subsidy is 700,000 yen.)





Tour around the 100 Selections of Treasure Troves in Numazu <No. 37> Ebara Soroku, our local giant, who made a great deal of effort for the development of education and industry in Numazu

Ebara Soroku was born in Edo in 1842. Soon after Meiji Restoration had started, *Soroku* moved to Numazu, where he established Numazu Military School and produced excellent human resources

there. Even after Numazu Military School was closed, establishing Shuseisha (present Dai-1 elementary school), Sunto girls' high school (present Numazu Nishi high school) and others, Soroku devoted his energy to the development of education in Numazu. He also worked on industrial promotion; he started western-style livestock farming, keeping cattle and sheep in Mt. Ashitaka, and cultivated tea trees, starting the business of exporting tea leaves to America. Having succeeded in persuading the government into giving up the nationalized land in Ashitaka to the local farmers is one of his remarkable services as well. In addition, Soroku played a great role as statesman for a long time after he was elected as one of the members of the House of Representatives, which took place when the Diet was convened for the first time in Japan. At the place where Soroku's resident used to stand, Meiji Historical Museum was built and it has been exhibiting the historical materials Soroku had left behind, and handing down his contribution.
