Dog owners are supposed to have their dogs vaccinated against rabies once a year.

Please have your dogs vaccinated at the animal hospitals by the end of June and receive a vaccination tag (a certificate) after that. Rabies vaccination is available at the animal hospitals listed below (charged).



# Feature

Tour of 100 Treasure Troves in Numazu No.38; *Izumi-suigenchi* (Fountain source of fresh water), which supplies safe and tasty water, a boast of Numazu



Public water supply in Numazu started in 1950, getting water from

Izumi-suigenchi, located in Yahata Shimizu-cho, is the biggest among the waterworks facilities in Numazu. It supplies drinking water with the areas of Numazu city and Shimizu-cho, taking the spring water from the deep well on the premises. The water is

not only sent to the distributing reservoirs in the areas of *Kanuki* or *Okamiya*, but also sent with pressure to each residence directly. The water conveyance control center in *Izumi-suigenchi* plays the role of a hub facility to monitor the centralized control system round-the-clock; managing the flow rate or water level of the sources and distributing reservoirs in the city. Water supplied in



Numazu is famous all over the country for its safety, low price, and tastiness; its quality is regularly inspected under the water supply law and furthermore the municipal original inspection items are also checked and the results always meet the safety standards. The abundant groundwater is sterilized only with chlorine, so the almost natural water can be supplied. Above all, the raw water itself is mild and nice. At present, the facilities of the control center are under reconstruction and on work order, but from next fiscal year they will be available for social studies field trips of elementary students, and others.
