Prevention of food poisoning

It is important to keep yourself from suffering from food poisoning during summer. Food poisoning is caused when bacteria and viruses adhere to hands or food such as meat and fish, and go into the body. There are three principles which are 'Don't put,' 'Don't increase,' and 'Sterilize' bacteria and viruses to prevent food poisoning during summer.

You can prevent it at home in the following ways.

- ① Make sure of the "best before" date, and eat all of the food so there are no leftovers.
- ② Keep the temperature in a refrigerator under 10° C and a freezer under -15° C.
- ③ Wash your hands with soap before you start cooking.
- ④ Wash cookware, dishcloths and sponge carefully and dry them well.

Symptoms of diarrhea and vomiting due to food poisoning are a defense reaction of the body trying to eliminate the causative agent. It's important to consult a doctor as soon as possible without taking medicine such as anti-diarrhea which is commercially available.

Prevention of Heat Stroke

You get heat stroke not only in summer but also in rainy season. Please take appropriate prevention from this season.

- ① When you are out, shade yourself from the sunlight and when you are in the room, use a fan or an air conditioners and wear lightweight clothing.
- ② Staying hydrated and eating balanced meal will prevent decreased strength.
- 3 When you feel hot and tired, please get rest.

Yoshioka Nao (6 years old), residing in Fuji city, developed 'fulminant myocarditis' last June, which was soon complicated with 'infarction' in the right side of the brain. Since then she has been forced to be in bed in a hospital, being unable to move her own body at will. To save her life, her parents have decided to have their daughter undergo cardiac transplant operation at



US Colombia University Hospital. However, the large amount of surgical cost, a lot of expenses for transferring and others amount to 270.000.000 yen, because cardiac transplant surgeries done in foreign countries are not covered by insurance in Japan. The family is striving to visit the USA this July, but the amount of money prepared so far is not enough for them to accomplish their purpose.

Your warm support will surely be helpful for Nao chan to have the surgery in America.
