# Aid Money for Designated Intractable Diseases (for the latter half of this fiscal year); applications are now being accepted

Municipal government provides the following people with aid money for designated intractable diseases; those who have the certificate for the beneficiary of Specified Medical Cost (Designated Intractable Diseases) issued by the prefecture. The certificate needs to have the distinguishing mark representing 'already being certified as a patient with designated intractable diseases', and it also needs to have the mark of 'patient with advanced disease' or 'patient with a ventilator or others' or 'Low I' or 'Low II'. Do not fail to make applications for the aid money within the application period.

How to apply: Applicants should come to the Health Center directly with the certificate for the beneficiary of Specified Medical Cost (Designated Intractable Diseases), which must be valid at the time of application, their *Inkan* (seal), and their own bank passbook. (Applicants who want to make a postal application should inform the Health Center accordingly.)
