## Information

#### =INFORMATION=

With the introduction of "The Social Security and Tax Number System", so-called "My Number System", Municipal Government will issue your "Individual Number Card".

Municipal government has been sending a "Notification Card" noting your "Individual Number" since this October to each of you holding a resident record in Numazu city, and in or after January 2016, the government will issue your "Individual Number Card" in exchange of the above-stated "Notification Card". Here is more information about "Individual Number Card", which should be convenient and have more opportunities to be used in the future.

### ◆Apply for your "Individual Number Card"◆

Each person holding a resident record in a municipality in Japan will be given a single Individual Number of 12 digits, which is generally called "My Number". Central government organizations and local governments and others handling personal information will use the Individual Numbers to efficiently manage personal information by tying the same Individual Number registered in different organizations quickly and precisely. The Individual Number is noted on a "Notification Card", which each of you has already received or will receive sequentially. You can exchange your "Notification Card" for your IC card with a photo called "Individual Number Card", which can be used as your personal identification.

### =Individual Number Card=





**How to apply:** First, fill out the application form enclosed in your "Notification Card". Then send it by mail with your photo in the envelope provided.

XYou can apply for the "Individual Number Card" on your PC or smart phone.

\*After the application, you will receive a notice letter which tells you that the municipal government is ready to issue your "Individual Number Card". You are required to come in person to the place where you can receive your "Individual Number Card", with necessary documents during the period for receiving.

\*For more details about the process of the procedures or the place you can receive your card, please check the information enclosed in your "Notification Card".

\*The "Individual Number Card" is valid until the 10<sup>th</sup> birthday from the date of issuance for people aged 20 years or older. (For people aged less than 20 years, the card will be valid until the 5<sup>th</sup> birthday from the date of issuance.) As for foreign people, the expiration period depends on their duration of stay.

### ◆More Opportunities to use the "Individual Number Card"◆

### ❖ As a means of a document for certificating your "My Number"

In many different cases where you need to present your "My Number", you can use this card as a certificate.

### \*As a means of personal identification when you need your identity verification

Opening an account at the financial facilities or having a passport issued newly requires you to present your "My Number" and your identity verification documents. The "Individual Number Card" is the only card that can fulfill both of the above-mentioned requirements at the same time.

### \*For utilizing "Public Certification Service for Individuals" (Japanese Public Key Infrastructure)

You can use the "Individual Number Card" for various administrative procedures online such as electronic applications with the electronic certificate in e-TAX and others.

### ◆Frequently Asked Questions about "My Number"◆

### Q1. Will it be possible to get the whole private information from the "Individual Number Card"?

A: No. The IC chip in the card does not contain any highly private information on incomes, clinical history, or others. Information in the card is limited to the information that is printed on its surface as well as the electronic certificate for utilizing the Public Certification Service for Individuals.

### Q2. Am I required to obtain the "Individual Number Card"?

A: No. You will not be forced to obtain the "Individual Number Card". However, it is highly recommended to apply for the card and obtain it because the card will simplify various administrative procedures and it will expand in application in the future.

## Q3. What should I do if my address or name has changed from the items printed on the "Individual Number Card"?

A: You are required to come in person with your "Individual Number Card" to the counter for the change of registered items. The new items will be added on your card. If you have the "Notification Card" and your name or address has changed, you'll have to follow the same procedure as well.

### Q4. Can I have my ID photograph for the "Individual Number Card" taken at the City Hall?

A: No. You need to prepare your ID photograph for the "Individual Number Card" by yourself before the application. **ID photograph:** 4.5 centimeters by 3.5 centimeters / face / without a hat or a cap / no background / an available oldest photo is the one taken 6 months ago.
