■What's "Photorogaining"?

"Photorogaining" is a sport in which participants collect points going around the check points within a limited time, taking photos of each check point, which need to be the same ones as the sample photos on the map used in this sport. Each check point has its set point and the figure is to be counted as a score. The higher score you achieve, the higher rank you reach. The key to reach higher rank seems to be a good strategy to go around each check point efficiently.

Dental checkup for children aged 18 months and consultation for rearing children are also available. There are communication salons "Angel Salon" and "Ohisama Hiroba". A variety of child support services will continue on.


