• People who have to file an income tax return:

*The self-employed or people who get income from real estate, or sold their land or buildings: Their total amount of income for 2015 exceeds the total amount of income

deduction like basic deduction or spouse allowance.

*Salaried workers applicable to any of the following cases below

- 1 People who earned more than 20 million yea a year.
- 2 People who received income from two or more places.
- 3 People who earned more than 200,000 yen in extra income over the past year.

*People whose income is only miscellaneous income from public pension, and have remains after income deduction

*People whose amount of pension is less than 4 million yen, and miscellaneous income except pension is less than 200,000 yen don't need to file an income tax return. (They need to file a tax return for a residence tax.) *Please ask Tax Office about the details.

*What you should bring with you when filing a tax return

- ① Inkan (personal seal)
- ⁽²⁾ The documents on which you added up your income and necessary expenses (e.g. certificate of taxes deducted, detailed statement of receipts and payments)
- ③ The documents necessary for deduction from income
 - *Certification of premium payment for social insurance, small enterprise mutual aid plan, national pension, national health insurance, medical insurance for the elderly, nursing-care insurance, life insurance, earthquake insurance, etc.
 - XIn case of filing a deduction for National Pension, a certificate sent from the Social Insurance Agency will be needed.

This is the system where you can declare and pay national taxes and do other procedures on the Internet. In order to use e-Tax, you need to be ready in advance. You must get an electronic certificate. (charged in City Hall, Citizen Division **3** 055-934-4721) You can refer to the National Tax Agency website.

Changes of Municipal and Prefectural Tax Payment in Fiscal Year 2016

* Housing Loan Deduction

Housing loan deduction is going to extend the coverage. Eligible persons will be among those who took up or will take up residence any time between 2009 (H21) and <u>the end of June, 2019 (H31)</u> and receive housing loan deduction on income tax, and who have a housing loan.

*Special Deduction (Used only for hometown tax payment donation)

The upper limit of tax deduction of inhabitant tax was doubled (from 10% to 20%), and a newsystem enabling tax deduction without filing a tax return (Hometown Tax Payment One-StopSpecial Provision System) was introduced. Please ask us about the details.

*City Prefectural Tax Withdrawal from Public Pension

As for city prefectural tax withdrawal from public pension, under the tax reform, the review of the calculation method is going to be implemented after Oct 1, 2016. However, the reform doesn't cause the increase or decrease of the annual tax amount. Please check the details on the city website or by your tax notice you'll receive in June.



In Numazu city, ambulances were sent out 9,282 times in 2015, and the number of the people who were transported to a hospital by ambulance was 8,120, more than 40 percent of which were not serious cases. Recently the number of inappropriate cases of calling an ambulance has been increasing and this could seriously jeopardize the

chances to save lives due to the delay of proper lifesaving measures.



<u>Visit to 100 Numazu Treasure Troves</u> No. 45 SL "D52-136" (Steam Locomotive in <u>Takazawa Park</u>)



There is a steam locomotive in Takazawa Park, about a 5-minute walk from Numazu Station. Since manufactured in 1944, it had been used as a freight locomotive on the Tokaido Line or Gotemba Line. After the Gotemba line became electrified, it was sent to Hokkaido, where it was retired in 1973 and completed its role. Afterwards, in response to Numazu citizens' requests, it was placed in Takazawa Koen, Numazu.
