

Dog owners have to register their dogs aged three months and over once in their lifetime, and have them vaccinated against rabies once a year. Please have your dogs vaccinated at the animal hospitals or designated vaccination sites listed below.



Things to bring: Dog vaccination book, vaccination notice postcard Fee: (differs from hospital to hospital) \pm 550 yen (for rabies vaccination tag)

*In case of a new dog, registration fee is required separately. (3,000 yen)

*If you get the injection at an animal hospital which isn't listed below, take the Rabies Vaccination Certificate to the Clean Center Management Division or Environmental Policy Division in City Hall, and get a rabies vaccination tag. (Fee: 550 yen)

What is ETC?

ETC (Electronic Toll Collection System) is a toll road automated radio collection system used in driving an expressway. By inserting your ETC card into the onboard equipment and driving in ETC-equipped tall lanes, the toll fare will be paid automatically.

*Smart IC is available only for cars using the ETC system (no longer than 12m)


*Drivers must stop the car briefly before the gate.

Tour around 100 Treasure Troves in Numazu NO.46: NUMAZUGAKI (a bamboo fence which has been handed down in Numazu)



Numazugaki is a bamboo fence which had long been used since ancient times in Numazu and its vicinity to prevent sand and wind from the beach. The landscape with Numazugaki is fascinating and its function as a windbreak or a sand-preventer is excellent. Since Numazugaki had been used in Old Numazu Imperial Villa as well, it came to be widely known to the public. Numazugaki is made of

thin bamboos (*Shino-dake*) called *Hakone-dake*. The bundles of ten culms of *Shino-dake* are weaved into a wickerwork-patterned fence. The way of weaving this wickerwork pattern is called "*Futa-te-goshi*", which means that each bundle of bamboo culms called "*te*" is weaved over two other "*te*". Today you can see these *Numazugaki* bamboo fences mainly in Numazu *Goyotei* (Imperial Villa) Memorial Park or in *Wakayama Bokusui* Museum.

— To hand down the skills of making Numazugaki to the next generation —

For the purpose of handing down the skills of making *Numazugaki* to the next generation, *Numazugaki* bamboo fences have been produced and sold at the public utility corporation Numazu Silver Human Resource Center. However, in recent years, they have been standing at the crossroads because the order quantity has been decreasing and the craftsmen have reached the age of retirement. The center held a training session for learning skills of making *Numazugaki* in order to hand down the tradition.



▲ *Kubota Eiichi san*, who was the instructor of the training session, has been producing *Numazugaki* for over 20 years. "Weaving bamboo culms one by one is hard work, but the beautiful wickerwork pattern with bamboo culms neatly set in a row really fascinates me," he says.
