

The Introduction to the Child-Raising Support Programs in Numazu City; here, we will introduce you to the various child-raising support programs provided by Numazu city in series.

*Subsidy for the Cost of Infertility Treatment and *Fuiku-sho* (Being subject to have a miscarriage or a stillborn child) Treatment*

For the purpose of reducing the economic burden of couples suffering from infertility, the city government subsidizes their medical expenses for the general infertility treatment, the specified infertility treatment, *Fuiku-sho* treatment, or other infertility treatment.

Applicants: Couples who fulfill all the following requirements; ①A married couple on the register whose husband or wife has the resident registration of Numazu city. ②The total family income of the previous year is under 7,300,000 yen. ③The wife's age on the first day of the treatment period is under 43. ④The treatment needs to be for the first child or the second child.

Amount of subsidy: A half of the total cost for the infertility treatment including the health insurance treatment, whose maximum amount is 300,000 yen for a couple per year.

Subsidization period: For the total of 5 years

How to apply: Within the fiscal year when the treatment was given, necessary documents need to be submitted to Health Center.

For Families with Three Children and More; the new system of reducing child-care fee and making no charge for child-care fee

As one of the measures against the population diminishment and the falling birthrate, the city government aims at increasing the number of the families with three children and more, focusing on the assistance measures for the families mentioned above as follows; the second child= the child-care fee for kindergartens, nursery schools, or designated day-care centers for children is reduced to half / the third child and the later children=no charge for child-care fee. Some limitations in the former system are to be removed with the introduction of the new system mentioned above.
