



## Please Make thorough Preparation against Earthquakes by Using Subsidy System

Once a big earthquake occurs, collapsed houses or fallen concrete block walls might take many lives. In order to save lives and secure evacuation routes, we advise you to repair concrete block walls and reinforce your houses.

## Subsidy for quakeproofing wooden houses



We will subsidize a part of the seismic retrofitting plan or reinforcement cost for the wooden houses built before May 31, 1981.

\*You have to apply for the subsidy before starting its reinforcement.

## The procedure

- ① Free diagnosis by an expert of earthquake resistance testing
- ② Drawing the seismic retrofitting plan, 96,000 yen will be subsidized.

  (In case of a family composed only of 65 year-old people or older, the subsidy is 144,000 yen.)
- ③ If you quakeproof your house, 500,000 yen will be subsided.

  (In case of a family composed only of 65 year-old people or older, the subsidy is 700,000 yen.)

## Subsidy for removal or repair of concrete block walls
