

◆Total Amount of Garbage Discharge

The total amount of garbage discharge in Numazu City in fiscal year 2015 was 62,312 tons, which includes burnable, landfill waste, plastic containers and packing, thermal recycling plastic and recyclable garbage. Converted into the amount per person per day, it becomes 852 g which is below the national and prefectural average.

About 60 percent of the weight of burnable garbage is water. Please drain excess water from kitchen waste to enable significant reduction of the amount of garbage. Numazu City would be grateful for your continued cooperation in waste reduction.

◆3 kiri Campaign

Food waste accounts for half the amount of burnable garbage. It often includes unopened food. Also, about 80 percent of food waste is moisture.

Let's start "3 kiri campaign" and reduce wasteful spending as well as garbage.

Tsukai-kiri (Use up): Don't buy too much food. Use up what you buy.

Tabē-kiri (Eat all): Don't cook too much. Keep food properly.

Mizu-kiri (Dry up): Squeeze and dry up food waste.

Kadoike Koen (Okaishhiki)

Kadoike is the only lake in our city and it has a garden path, lawn field and some play equipment on the north side.

Ushibuse-yama Koen (Shimokanuki)

You enjoy the scenery of the coastline, Ushibuse hill and pinewoods. The park has an abundance of native plants.

Katahama-Kita Koen (Nishimakado)

There is a large field where you can enjoy play equipment and ball playing. It also has facilities for preparing against disaster, such as utility toilets and underground water tanks.

What is Numazu *Kenkou* Mileage?

We've started a campaign called 'Numazu *Kenkou* Mileage' in order to encourage our citizens, students, and those who commute to the city, to maintain their health regardless of their age. In this system, you put your own health program into action, record the result and get points, which the city issues. These points can be replaced into "*Fujino-kuni Kenkou Ikiiki Card*."

You can challenge until Jan. 31(Tue), 2017.

You can exchange your points into the other card

between July 1(Fri), 2016 and Feb. 28(Tue), 2017.

How to use Numazu *Kenkou* Mileage

(1) Let's get a point sheet!

You can get a point sheet at the Health Center, City Gym, and Citizens office.

You can also download one at Numazu City Web site.

(2) Practice your program and save the points!

You'll choose the following menu for your health and save 30 points from four menus.

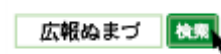
Menu	Points	Examples
Food	1 point for good diet	To eat vegetables each meal every day To drink green tea
Exercise	1 point for an exercise	To do radio gymnastics Not to smoke

Bond	1 point for an action	To take part in the volunteer activities To join the community activities
Health	2 points for health check and others	To undergo a medical examination To take a lecture on health

(3) You can exchange your points into “*Fujino-kuni Kenkou Ikiiki Card*.”
When you get 30 points in total, you can get a card with a lot of benefits.
About 800 shops in the city and Shizuoka pref. are supporting this system.
EX. 5% discount for food and drink, some gifts and so on

Information~~Dog Registration and Rabies Prevention Vaccination

Dog owners are supposed to have their dogs vaccinated against rabies once a year.
Please have your dogs vaccinated at the animal hospitals by the end of June and
receive a vaccination tag (a certificate) after that. Rabies vaccination is available at the animal
hospitals listed below (charged).

Things to bring: Dog vaccination book (a dog card)

Fee: (differs from hospital to hospital) + 550 yen (for rabies vaccination tag)

*If you have a new dog, you need to register him/her and pay for the registration.

Registration fee: 3,000 yen
