In the last fiscal year, more than 300 people utilized the consultation services, and about 100 of them got a job. The Center also provides the learning support service for junior high-school students who cannot afford the tuition of a cram school, getting-job preparation support service for those who have been unemployed for some time or those who have lost confidence in working. Volunteers who can cooperate with our staff to support consulters are now wanted as well. Call us first, do not be distressed alone!

***** Job Assistance *****

For those who have difficulty in getting a job because of their insecurity about social participation and others, the Center provides opportunities to acquire the ability of social adjustment, opportunities of work training, and others, as getting-job preparation support services.

⇔ Securement of Living Place **⇔**

To those who have lost their living places or who have a high risk of losing their living places because they quit their jobs, the equivalent amount of house rent is subsidized on a temporary basis under some conditions such as job-hunting, and others.

***Temporary Livelihood Support ***

For those who are unhoused, the Center provides an accommodation, food and clothing for a certain period in an emergency move, and it also supports their self-reliance so that they will be able to lead a solid residential life for the future.

‡Leaning Support for Children **‡**

For junior high-school students and their parents in needy families, the Center provides support services for children's bright future; learning support, support services for students who want to go on to high school, support services for preventing students from dropping out of school, and others.

Now it's a season when ticks are active. Try not to get bitten by ticks.

If you get bitten by ticks infected with germs, you can infrequently get severely diseased.

*What kind of symptoms?

If you get a fever or rash two to eight days after getting bitten by ticks, see a doctor as soon as possible.

*How to prevent?

① When you walk in the grass fields, you had better cover your skin with long sleeve shirts, trousers, or shoes.

② Bug spray is also effective in combination with other protecting measures.

Be Careful! Heatstroke!

Heatstroke starts to develop in rainy season and increases in July and August. Let's take preventative measures against it.

- ① Check room temperature with a thermometer
- ② Drink enough liquid before you feel thirsty.
- 3 Take a rest when you feel hot or tired.
- ④ Get enough nutrition to build up your strength.
