

It's SUMMER!!! To the Aquariums! Extra Tour around 100 Treasure Troves in Numazu Numazu is the only city in the prefecture that has no less than three aquariums!

An aquarium must be one of the main destinations of family outing in summer. *Awashima* Marine Park, Numazu Port Deep-Sea Aquarium, and *Izu-Mito* Sea Paradise are all aquariums located in Numazu city. "3 aquariums in 1 city" is a very rare case nationally. In addition, a municipal aquarium had been in *Senbonhama* Park until the fiscal year 1963. In this extra tour for summer, you will be introduced to the three aquariums with plenty to see. How about going on a trip around the aquariums?



Numazu Municipal Aquarium: the aquarium had been open from the fiscal year 1950 to 1963. Fish dwelling in Suruga Bay and deep-sea fish were exhibited in the aquarium, and about 50,000 people visited there per year.
