

<u>Hi, U-san!</u> [Vol. 14]

You need not pay medical expenses for your third child (except for your first and second children) from October onward. That's because we aim to reduce the burden of medical expenses. The payment for the outpatient care is free until a child becomes 15 years old. The payment for hospitalization is free until a child becomes 18 years old. At the end of September, we start to send new cream-colored



identifications of recipients to their guardians. You need to show your insurance card and the identification of recipient when you go to a medical institution. If your first and second children live outside of this city because of studying at university and you send money as the cost of living to them, your third child can get this benefit. In such a case, you bring health insurance card for your third child and seal to Health Center or Heda's Health Center, and apply for that.


