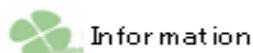
Childcare

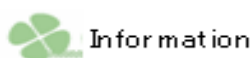

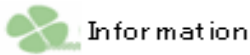

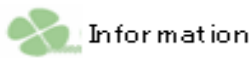
