#### New Service about getting Registry Certificates

You can get Registry Certificates as well as a copy of Resident card and Certificate of registered seal at convenience stores after Jan. 4(Wed), 2017. Please make use of the service. Also, Automatic issuing machines, which are in City Hall and Numazu Shinyo Kinko (Takashima-cho branch), stop the current service on Dec. 31(Sat).



Fee: 450 yen

What is issued: your own present certificate of individual records and its copy

(Your registered domicile and address need to be in Numazu City.)

Attention: You can't get a certified copy of Closed Family Register or a certified copy of Invalidated Family Register. If your resident registration hasn't been done in Numazu City, you can't make use of this service. The change of the contents may not be reflected within 2 weeks after you report your family register.

\*Available hours: 6:30 ~ 23:00

You can't use this service during the following periods.

Year end and New Year [between Dec. 29(Thu) and Jan. 3(Tue)],

During the maintenance [①Dec. 20(Tue), 6:30~12:00 / ②Jan. 18(Wed) all day]

\*To use this service, you have to show your "My Number Card," which is the nickname of the card for The Social Security and Tax Number System. Refer to the City website for further details.

\*Your "*Shimin Card*" (citizen's card) is necessary for the issuance procedure of Certificate of Registered Seal at the window, so please keep it.

The year-end and New Year holidays are the time when family members often get together. Let's take this opportunity and talk about how we can deal with the troubles if we face consumers' troubles or bank transfer frauds.

### A recent example of troubles

#### A Trial Period into Regular Purchase

I ordered goods at a trial price much below the regular price. But, a month later, I receive goods

with a bill of regular purchase. When I contacted the dealer, I found I made a contact of regular purchase without noticing it.



The words, like “Monitor Price” “Free Trial” “You only have to pay for shipping,” attract people and make them order easily over the Internet. If there is a condition of regular purchase written somewhere on the site, it means you understand the condition and order it. So, before you order, make sure of conditions and agreements.

#### **Protection Measures against Bursting Cold Water Pipe**

During winter, water pipes are likely to freeze. If it freezes, it gets damaged or water does not flow. Here are some ways to prevent frozen pipes. Please attach thermal insulators to exposed water pipes. You can buy them at a shop, but you can substitute them with cloth and blankets. In addition, please cover the water meter device with cloth to prevent it from freezing.
