Have You Claimed Two Welfare Benefits?

<Special Welfare Benefit>

Applicant: A person who is not imposed municipal tax in 2016.

Allowance: 3,000 yen per person

<Benefit for disability/survivors basic pension>

Applicant: A person who receives disability or survivor basic pension among people who are eligible or temporary welfare benefit.

Allowance: 30.000 yen per person

*If you receive temporary welfare benefit for supporting elderly people with low income then you can't apply.

Be careful about PM2.5 (micro particle substance)

What is PM2.5?

It is a particle under-2.5-micrometers which floats in the atmosphere. Its diameter is one-thirtieth as long as that of a single hair. According to an immunological survey, it has been obvious that PM2.5 is easy to be inhaled into the deep bottom of lungs. *One micrometer is one-thousandth as long as 1 millimeter.

What to do if "the information calling for attention to PM2.5" has been announced?

When the prefectural government announces "the information calling for attention to PM2.5", the information will be provided for people through each area's simultaneous radio transmission. Those who have disorders in their respiratory system or their circulatory system, small children and elderly people need to pay more attention to PM2.5.

^{*}If a person who supports his/herself is imposed tax or receives welfare, he/she is excluded.

^{*}To refrain from going out if you don't have to.

^{*}To refrain from working or playing outdoors

*To wear virus-proof masks or dust-proof masks that can deal with PM2.5 more effectively.

·There are 30 measurement stations all over the prefecture and they are making observation of air pollution 24 hours a day. Their measured data and forecast information can be checked on the website "Shizuoka Prefecture Air Pollution Constant Observation System."
