Information

One-Day Chief of Numazu Police Station; the most excited 'Police Commander' in the world!



The famous professional soccer player Nakayama Masashi, who belongs to Azul Claro Numazu, which is going to participate in J3 from this season, took office as 'one-day police commander' at Numazu Police Station on January 10 (Tue), Day of Emergency Call 110, making an appeal to the citizens about the proper usage of the emergency call 110, the caution against billing fraud, and traffic safety.

◆ Be Careful not to be Cheated by Billing Fraud!

Within the jurisdiction of Numazu Police Station, the amount of damage from particular kinds of fraud summed up to 210,000,000 yen last year, with 24 cases. (This is the provisional value as of Jan. 2017) They are 16 cases of 'It's me' fraud (the amount of damage is about 40,000,000 yen), 1 case of billing fraud (the amount of damage is about 140,000,000 yen), and others. 80 % of the victims were elderly women. When you get a suspicious phone call, don't hesitate to talk to the

police, city consumer's life center, or your family members about the call.

❖Did you ever think of Returning your Driver's License to the authorities?

For the purpose of reducing the number of traffic accidents caused by elderly drivers, the municipal government encourages elderly drivers to return their driver's license voluntarily to the police if they feel anxious about their driving skills. Numazu citizens aged 65 and over who have returned their unexpired driver's license voluntarily to the police are to be provided with the tickets of 5,000 yen (50×100-yen ticket) for taking a bus or a taxi, which can be used by their family as well. The tickets should be used for taking taxis or buses of cooperative companies within the city. If you have felt anxious about your driving skills even slightly, returning your driver's license voluntarily to the authority must be one of the choices for you.

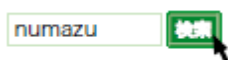
