Don't Forget to Register When You Move!

The Procedures You Should Go through When Moving

A lot of people are planning to move because of a new job or going on to college in the spring. We will introduce the necessary steps to take when moving. Please check the City website.

Register your change of address within 14 days when moving

The contents will be registered on the Basic Resident Registration Card and become valuable data which proves your address.

Necessary items when you apply for the following certificates

* A copy of your family register (for all or a member) Document of identification (A Power of Attorney (<i>Ininjo</i>)) is necessary to submit when you are not a lineal relative.)	* A copy of resident card Document of identification (A Power of Attorney is necessary to submit when you aren't a member of the same household.)
* A seal registration certificate Your seal registration or your citizen's card that has the seal registration (You can't get a seal registration certificate only with your registered seal.)	

***The registration of moving in or out including birth and death is obligated by the law.**



We ask you for confirmation of your identity

In order to prevent false registration by another person, we check each person who comes to register the change of address (moving in or out), or family register (affiliation, marriage, divorce, adoption of child, dissolution). So please present some documents which identify you at the time of registration. When a deputy submits the registration, the letter of attorney is necessary.

~~~Dog Registration and Rabies Prevention Vaccination~~~

Dog owners have to register their dogs aged three months and over once in their lifetime, and have them vaccinated against rabies once a year from April to June. Please have your dogs vaccinated at designated vaccination sites listed below or the animal hospitals. If your dog is too nervous or fearful and easily agitated, you'd better take your dog to an animal hospital rather than group vaccination site.



Group Vaccination

Things to bring: Dog vaccination book (a dog card), notice postcard

Fee: 2,850 yen + 550 yen (for rabies vaccination tag) = 3,400 yen

In case of a new dog, registration fee is required separately. (3,000 yen)

*Please bring exact change.

*Group vaccination is held rain or shine.

*Do not come to the site by car. No parking lot

*Put a dog tag and rabies tag on your dog.

If you have concerns about your dog's health condition, consult with your veterinarian before your dog receives the vaccination.

At Animal Hospital

Things to bring: Dog vaccination book, vaccination notice postcard

Fee: (differs from hospital to hospital) + 550 yen (for rabies vaccination tag)

*In case of a new dog, registration fee is required separately. (3,000 yen)

*If you get the injection at an animal hospital which isn't listed below, take the Rabies Vaccination Certificate to the Clean Center Management Division or Environmental Policy Division in City Hall, and get a rabies vaccination tag. (Fee: 550 yen) 16

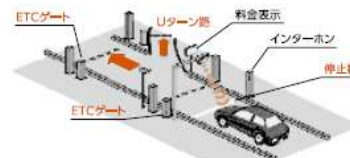

Why the citizen calendar starts at April?

The citizen calendar has been published since 1993 so that people could get information related to the city. In order to gather information and post it on the calendar, we publish it in April. Besides, it doesn't compete with other commercial calendars. Citizen survey in 2016 shows that 51.5 percent of people are satisfied with the calendar which starts at April, while only 7 percent of people hope that it would start in January.

“Comprehensive Project for Preventive Long-Term Care and Daily Life Support” Begins in April ~ So that seniors can continue to be active and healthy living in a familiar environment

Due to revisions in the Long-Term Care Insurance System, a program called “The Comprehensive Project for Preventive Long-Term Care and Daily Life Support” begins in April.

▲Background of the Project

The number of elderly people living on their own and/or with dementia is estimated to increase through the year 2025 when baby boomers become aged 75 and older. Because of this, community-based support systems need to be established in addition to already-existing Long-Term Care Services. This will enable elderly people to continue living in environments familiar to them. This project will provide flexible services based on each individual's condition and life style to support independence, social involvement and a purposeful life for the elderly.

▲Variety of the Services of the Comprehensive Projects

There are two projects. “Preventive Long-Term Care and Livelihood Support Services Project” is available for the elderly people who are qualified as Support Required 1 and 2 or who show functional decline in activities of daily living evaluated by the Basic Health Check list. The other one is “General Preventive Long-Term Care Project” available for everyone aged 65 and older.

Preventive Long-Term Care and Livelihood Support Services Project

Home-Visit Services
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Home-visit preventive long-term care service Physical care such as changing clothes, toileting, etc. and living support ◆ Relaxed standard home-visit Service Living support services such as cleaning, washing, etc., excluding physical care
Day Services

Preventive Long-Term Care Management
The community-based Integrated Care Center make a care plan with the elderly and his/her family to support independent life in the community.

General Preventive Long-Term Care Project

Physical exercise classes for preventive long-term care, lectures for taking active and social roles in the community (class to improve muscle strength, preventive dementia program, various supporter training courses, etc.)

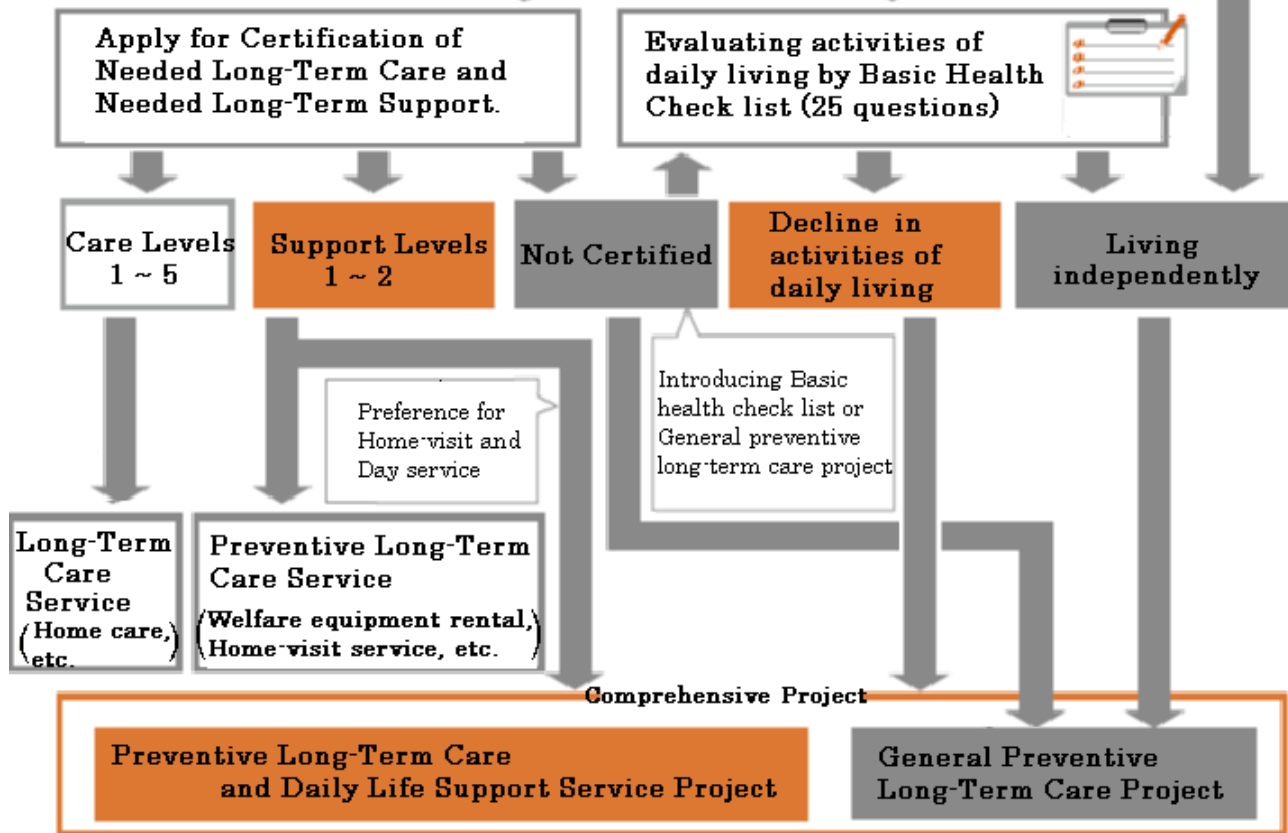

Tour around 100 Treasure Troves in Numazu NO.54; the Ruins of *Koukokuji* Castle ~
the castle playing a key role in Eastern Suruga disturbance during the Sengoku Period ~

Heading along the Prefectural Highway *Hara-Teishaba* Route, which runs north and south straight from near JR Hara station, you will see the former site of *Koukokuji* Castle lie at the skirts of a magnificent mountain *Ashitakayama*. *Koukokuji* is thought to have been the castle where *Hojo Souun*, the founder of *Hojo* Family, who controlled the area throughout *Kanto*, raised an army, and the castle was named after the temple which used to be there. This area had been at the border zone with *Izu*, *Kai*, *Sagami*, and other provinces. So the borders had been shifted so many times because of the territorial dispute among powerful warriors; *Hojo*, *Imagawa*, *Takeda*, and other families. During the dispute over 120 years, the castellan changed so many times and the appearance of the castle changed as well. The remains we can see today are said to have belonged to the period of the last castellan, *Amano Yasukage*. The last appearance of *Koukokuji* castle was

characterized by the enormous earthworks surrounding the inner citadel and the huge dry moat behind the *Den Tenshudai* (donjon), and others. Thanks to the longtime excavation research, the castle's structure at the last stage and that before the last have been made clear gradually. In 1995, the ruins of the castle were designated as a national historic site, the castle which tells us the opening of the Sengoku Period (the age of provincial wars). In years to come, restoration and adjustment will be carried out to make the site a historical park.

~ Chronological Table of *Koukokuji* Castle ~

1487 (Chokyo 1)	Koukokujijo was given to Hojo Souun by Imagawa Family.
1549 (Tenbun 18)	A massive renovation of the castle was undergone by Imagawa Yoshimoto.
1569 (Eiroku 12)	Against the invasion of Suruga area by Takeda Shingen, Hojo family took over Koukokujijo.
1572 (Genki 3)	Reconciliation between Takeda family and Hojo family allowed Takeda to take over Koukokujijo.
1582 (Tenshou 10)	Because of the downfall of Takeda family, Tokugawa family took over the castle.
1590 (Tenshou 18)	Because of the downfall of Hojo family, Tokugawa family moved to Kanto area, and the castle was taken over by Kawage Shigetsugu, a subordinate warrior of Nakamura (Toyotomi) family.
1601 (Keicho 6)	After the Battle of Sekigahara, Amano Yasukage, a subordinate warrior of Tokugawa family, took over the castle.
1607 (Keicho 12)	After Amano Yasukage concealed himself from the castle, the castle was made to be deserted.
