Financial Aid for the Pregnant and the Newborn

Financial aid will be increased for pregnant women, who get a health check. In addition, we will provide financial aid for Group B Streptococcus Screening and for the Newborn Hearing Screening, which is a test to identify moderate, severe and profound deafness and hearing impairment in newborn babies.

The Statue of Hakuin Zen Master Is Designated as Tangible Cultural Property

Zen Master, Hakuin Ekaku, revived *Rinzai* school in the Edo period and is affectionately called “Hakuin-san in Hara”. It is the 250th year after his death, and the Numazu Board of Education designated the wooden seated statue of Hakuin Zen Master, owned by Shoinji Temple, as a tangible cultural property.

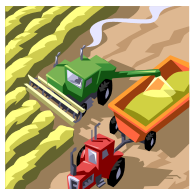
