## **★** "Special Payment System for Students" for National Pension Scheme fee

Target: Students with their preceding year income of below 1.18 million yen

**Where:** Resident Registration Division, 1F in City office or the section in charge in each municipal office **Details:** There is a system called "Special Payment System for Students" to which students unable to pay National Pension Scheme fees can apply for the grace. In view of receiving the future pension, utilize the system.

What to bring: A seal (*hanko*), your pension handbook, your student ID card or its copy (both sides) and the original certificate of enrolment.

Notes:

 $\$ You need to renew the application every year.

An application covering up to 2 years and a month before the application date is available. **Contact: C**055-934-4724 Municipal division (National pension section)

### **★** Subsidize the treatment expenses for infertility and recurrent miscarriages

**Aim:** Reduce the financial burden for the general and special infertility and recurrent miscarriage treatments.

People who can apply: All the 4 requirements should be fulfilled:

1. The couple should be registered as a family and either the husband or the wife should be a registered citizen in Numazu at the time of the application.

2. The total income of the couple should not exceed 7 million 300 thousand yen per year. (The income in January to May from the past two years and the income from June to December from last year will be considered.)

3. The age of the wife should be under 43-year-old on the first day of treatment.

4. It should be the treatment for the first or the second child.

**Amount of subsidy:** Half the amount of all the medical treatment expenses. The upper limit is 300 thousand yen per year for one couple.

Assisting period: 5 years in total



★ Application for receiving a subsidy for the 2nd term health care system: medical checkup of the brain for the elderly Consultation period: July 1st (Sun) - December 31st (Mon)









**Target:** People living in Numazu city, insured by the 2nd term health care system for the elderly, and complete payers of the last year's insurance premium

% People born prior to 1943/8/31 can also apply (the consultation will be available after the 75th birthday)

Quota: 150 people maximum

**Amount of subsidy:** 40 thousand yen (the charge for individuals will differ at each medical institution) **Application:** By telephone (You need your policy certificate at hand to confirm the insured personal numbers.)

Application period: May 14th(Mon) - June 15th (Fri)

XIf there're too many applications, we will have a lucky draw and contact people afterwards who can receive the subsidy.
