★TOPIC 1

What: Let's prepare for and prevent potential landslide disasters!

Landslide is a disaster that mountains or cliffs suddenly crumble down, or rocks and sands mixed with water that flow out from rivers, due to heavy rains or earthquakes.

Preparation:

- 1. Prior investigation of hazardous places: Within the city, 382 places are regarded as dangerous. Visit our website to check out those places on the Landslides Hazard Map.
- 2. Recognizing your designed evacuation spot and the routes
- 3. Preparation for evacuation supplies
- 4. Information from media (TV, radio)
- 5. Registration on Crisis Management Information Mail service

Landslide Warning

Shizuoka Local Meteorological Observatory announces a Landslide Warning when there is an increasing risk of landslides due to heavy rains. This announcement is aimed to prompt citizens to evacuate and prevent the loss of lives due to a disaster.

Means of announcement

It would be announced as breaking news on TV or radio, by community radio, or Crisis Management Information Mail service.

People who does not have any income, or people who are not required to declare an income due to the tax law (People who are only with non-taxable pension such as survivor's pension, disability pension) might have reduced the insurance premium by the declaration.

Citizens who do not need to declare the ones who are done declaring their income or municipal/prefectural tax; ones who are receiving national pension or welfare pension; ones who are presented a salary payment report from their place of employment.


