


Topic 1★ Assistance to single-parent family

◆ Do not forget the application for the child-rearing allowance

When (Application period): August 1st (Wed) – 7th (Tues) (Except Saturday, Sunday)

Where: Child Support Division, 1F City hall

Topic 2★ Please take hepatitis screening

When: July 23rd to 29th is "liver health campaign week" and July 28th is "Japan hepatitis day"

If you are infected with hepatitis virus at an early stage, there are no recognizable symptoms and the disease could progress before you recognize it. In Numazu city, the hepatitis screening is conducted until October 31st (Wed).

Who: People aged 40 or above who never had hepatitis screening

XScreening is also conducted at Eastern Shizuoka Prefecture Health Center. Please call ☎055-920-2109 for a reservation.

- People who are infected with Type-B hepatitis virus

 Those who have hepatitis B virus may be able to receive benefits paid by the national government depending on the stage of clinical condition. The deadline of the application for the benefits has been extended to Jan.12, 2022. Please call the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare Telephone for a consultation about Type-B hepatitis at \$\infty\$03-3595-2252.
- People who are infected with Type-C virus

 For people who infected Type-C hepatitis by the administration of coagulant, may be able to receive benefits paid by the national government. The deadline of the application for the benefits is until January 15th, 2023. Please call the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare Telephone consultation service about fibrinogen preparations at 20120-509-002.

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Topic 3 ★Please donate food for the needy; Setting up food collection boxes

Food Bank "Fujinokuni" is collecting food from individuals or companies, which would be thrown away due to various reasons even though they are still safe to eat. The organization will distribute the donated food to the people or institutions who are having difficulty of purchasing enough food because of poverty.

The city is supporting the activity called "Summer Food Drive" which administered by this organization. We will set up a food collection box in places such as city hall and others. We appreciate your cooperation in the donation of food.

When: August 1st (Wed) - August 31st (Fri)

Where: Besides the general information center on the first floor of the city hall; Numazu city social welfare council on the second floor of San-Well Numazu

Food to be collected: Unopened food with the period of 2 months and more until the by-use date. The food that could be stored at room temperature such as rice, canned food, instant food products, pouch-packed food, and others. Perishable goods are not accepted.

Topic 4 ★ News from the Disability Welfare Division

◆ Application of special child rearing allowance, children's disability welfare allowance, mentally and physically disabled children's home welfare allowance, special disability allowance and transitional welfare allowance

When (Application period): August 1^{st} (Wed) -7^{th} (Tues)

The required documents will be sent to the relevant people.

◆ Update your application of the medical expenses subsidy certificate for developmentally disabled person (child)

Who:

- 1. People who have the grade 1, 2, or 3 physical disability certificate. (People who are above 20 years old and have grade 3 physical disability certificate which have disability inside their body)
- 2. People who have rehabilitation certificate A or B. (People who is younger than 20 years old is the target for rehabilitation certificate B)
- 3. People who have the grade 1 mentally disabled certificate
- 4. People who receive special child rearing allowance (People who is receiving the children medical expenses subsidy is excluded)

How to apply: Check the received document and send or pass the required documents directly

When (application period): August 1st (Wed) – 13th (Mon) directly; August 1st (Wed)~ 17th (Fri) by mail

Where: City hall annex, welfare division for persons with disabilities

- *There is a chance that one could not use the system (ex. income restrictions or not submitted)
- ◆ Medical expense subsidy for medical care of people with mental disabilities
 Amount of subsidy: One third of the money is given as a benefit
 Who:
 - 1. People with mental disabilities who live in Numazu and has been hospitalized for more than 3 months.

2. People who received the medical expense and hospitalized again within 6 months.

How to apply: Pass the required documents directly.

When (application period): From the assigned subsidy consultation month until next year on the same month (one year)

- 1. People whose incomes meet the standard income criteria
- 2. People who live or work in Numazu
- 3. People who urgently need houses
- 4. People who are not gang members
