\star We support the elderly drivers to return their driver's license voluntarily

In order to decrease the number of car accident caused by the elderly drivers, we support the drivers whose age is 65 or above and returning their driver's license voluntarily. If you are anxious about your driving, don't you think about returning your driver's license?

- *Who:* A person who lives in Numazu city, whose age is 65 or above, and has a valid driver's license.
- *Details of support*: A 5,000-yen taxi ticket (50 tickets of 100 yen) will be provided for the person or a family member of the person who returns the driver's license. The taxi ticket can be used with any cooperating taxi company in Numazu city.

*The license which is not renewed and invalid does not count as the voluntary return.

*Application period is until 6 months after returning the driver's license and can be applied once.

- Procedure 1: Returning of the driver's license
 - \circ Go to East Driving and Vehicle Licensing Center (Ashitaka) or Numazu Police Office
 - Bring your Driver's license.
 - Documents provided are (1) Notice card of cancellation of driver's license. (2) Driver's license which confirmed as invalid.
 - X A form that shows your driving history which can be used as a personal ID can be provided. (Service Charge-1100 yen)
- Procedure 2: Granting of bus and taxi tickets
 - \circ Go to City Hall 2nd floor- local government division or Heda Citizen Service Office
 - Bring the following: (1) Personal Seal (2) The Driving License Cancellation form that was provided after the cancellation (3) Confirmation of cancellation of the license or a Driving History Certificate, a copy of a form that shows self- confirmation ※Confirm/contact for detail

★ Please be careful with infectious diseases in winter!

Winter is a season for viruses to breed because the environment is cold, and the humidity is low. Influenza and norovirus are especially infectious in the winter. Please do what you can do to prevent those diseases. Here are some of the basic information of the diseases and how to prevent them.

Influenza



- Symptoms: Fever over 38^oC, sore throat, coughing, headache, joint ache, muscle ache, general malaise etc.
- To prevent infection: ① Wash your hands and gargle when you get home ② Keep adequate humidity in your room ③ Take enough rest and have balanced meals ④ Get a vaccine against influenza
- Norovirus- Norovirus is the cause of infectious disease. It usually gets passed on from people's hands, fingers, and food.
 - Symptoms: Vomiting, stomachache, diarrhea etc.
 - To prevent infection: ① Wash your hands and gargle when you get home ② Heat the food well ③ Disinfect the cooking wares and kitchen well ④ Be careful when cleaning infected people's vomit or feces



Let's follow the "Rules for Coughing"

Most of the infectious diseases are spread by releasing the virus or bacteria in the air through sneezing or coughing. Therefore, please wear the masks or cover your nose and mouth with a tissue so as not to infect others.
