※ Special system for deferring collection of city tax

- What: For people whose income related to business etc. has decreased considerably due to the influence of
 the new coronavirus infection, payment of upcoming individual city tax, corporate municipal tax, property tax,
 etc which the deadlines are from February 1st of the current year (Sat) to January 31st of the next year (Sun)
 will be deferred for a maximum of 1 year without guarantee and late fees.
- Conditions: Taxpayer special collection duty person who meets all the following requirements (regardless of business orner/individual)
 - 1. For any period (1 month or more) after February,2020 the amount of business income has decreased by 20% or more compared to the same period of the previous year.
 - 2. For people who are having difficulties in paying the target city tax at one time
- **Application:** Go to city tax administration division(Nozei Kanri ka) on the second floor of the city hall or by mail or eLTAX with the necessary documents attached to the prescribed form on the city homepage
- **Application deadline:** Tuesday, June 30th, or the later of each deadline, whichever is later (if the deadline is extended, the extended deadline will apply)
 - This special system can be used retroactively even for city taxes that are past due on the theory after February 1st (Saturday).
 - To apply, it is necessary to submit the documents that show the status of income or bank statement deposits, but if it is difficult to submit, please contact us.

% Injury and Sickness Allowance Payment System


- **Details:** If the insured person of the City's National Health Insurance or Medical System for the Elderly is infected with Covid-19, etc., we will pay the Injury and Sickness Allowance for the period during which you cannot work due to medical treatment.
- **Subject:** All who meet the following requirements
 - 1. Those insured by the Numazu City National Health Insurance or the Medical System for the Elderly
 - 2. An employee receiving payment such as salary
 - 3. If you are infected with a new coronavirus infection, or if you have a fever or other symptoms and are suspected to be infected, and you cannot work due to medical treatment.
- Payment Amount: Total amount of income (such as salary) for the last three consecutive months ÷ working days x 2/3 x number of days eligible for payment
- **Period of Payment:** Period from the day when three days have passed since the day when he/she was no longer able to work (up to 1 year and 6 months), between January 1st (wed.) to September 30th (wed.)
- How to Apply: Directly or mail the prescribed form in the National Health Insurance Section on the 1st floor of City Hall
 - *If you wish to apply, please contact us by phone in advance
 - *If you can receive all or part of your salary, the payment amount may be adjusted or not paid.

Exemption system of the National Pension

- What: A system for Pension Insurance Group 1 citizens whose income decreased by a huge amount, and
 are having trouble paying National Pension, and for those whose income is predicted to be low or to be
 equivalent to standard income of National Pension exemption. You might be able to receive full exemption,
 postpone or partial exemption.
- **Details:** You will need a national pension premium exemption grace form or Special Application form for student payment, your income statement form, A copy of both sides of your student card or a document that proves that you belong to a certain school (Only if you are applying for student payment), Identity confirmation documents (driver's licence etc.), Hanko
- Target Period: From February to June (For student payment exceptions, February of the current year to March of 2021)
- Where: Applications will be available at the citizen section at the Numazu city hall (1st floor). Bring your application form etc. to the Citizen window counselling office or Numazu pension office with you. You can either mail it or take it to the city hall on your own.

Be Careful of Heatstroke

Heatstroke develops not only during the middle of summer but also during the rainy season. Check frequently if there are any changes in your physical condition and be mindful to prevent the heatstroke. Points of prevention:

- ① Use air conditioners/ fans, and check the room temperature
- 2 Wear hats/UV umbrellas when going outside
- 3 Frequently hydrate yourself, before you feel thirsty
- 4 Take a rest, if you feel hot or tired
- ⑤ Get enough nutrients/sleep to strengthen your body

X Be Careful of Food Poisoning

Food poisoning occurs when particular bacteria or viruses adhere to the food that we eat. In preventing food poisoning, from bacteria, keeping the three principles is very important: "not putting bacteria on food", "not increasing the number of bacteria on the food", and "to sterilize the bacteria that adhered to our food/cooking equipment."

Points of prevention:

1 Wash! Use wisely!

There are various bacteria on your hands. Wash your hands when touching food. Also, when storing food, use a closed container.

2Store at lower temperatures!

You should store your food in a refrigerator as soon as you buy it.

3Sterilize = Heat!

For almost all bacteria, they die when they are heated. Heating at around 75°C for 1 minute is preferable. Be sure to clean the cooking equipment as well.
