## **%** Announcement from the City Hospital **%**

What: Medical treatment payment will be changed from October 1st

 Due to the partial revision of rules for Insurance Medical Institution and Insurance Medical Care regulations, from October 1<sup>st</sup> the fees for the special first visit as well as the fees for the special revisit will be changed as follows.

- Special first visit charge is an expense a patient has to pay with the charge for a patient's first visit when a patient consults without an introduction card from the other medical institution for the first visit.
- Special revisit charge is an expense a patient has to pay with the revisit charge when a patient consults
  the city hospital, despite there being no more symptoms and an introduction to a local practitioner in
  the region has been made.

▶The city hospital will support everyone's health by cooperating with a family doctor as a local medical care support hospital.

#### • What is a local medical support hospital?

A hospital which obtains the approval from the prefectural governor to offer better medical care and aims for the improvement of the quality of whole local medical care by cooperating with local medical care institutions (family doctor).

• We will provide medical care in cooperation with a family doctor.

Please first have a medical examination by a family doctor when you do not feel well. A family doctor will introduce the city hospital whenever technical treatment or hospitalization is needed. Then, the city hospital will introduce a near medical care institution when the symptoms are being stable or entered to a chronic period.

Please contact the city hospital when it is an emergency such as during the night-time or holiday.

### **Special Health Check-up**

- What: Don't forget to take the special health check-up (medical check-up)
   Let's take a medical check-up once a year to reconfirm the health condition. By using the
   Numazu health check-up consultation ticket, the cost may be reduced or could be free during the health check-up period.
- When: Until October 31st (Sat)
- Who:
  - ① Age over 40 and is a member of the Numazu national health insurance
  - ② Member of the medical-care system for the latter-stage elderly
- Details:
  - Things to bring: health check-up ticket (Sent to targets in early days in June), health insurance card
  - Cost 1 800yen 2 Free
    - ※ Please contact if you do not have the health check-up ticket

#### Distribution of the Maternal and Child Health Handbook

- What: Maternal and Child Health Handbook is important as it records the course of pregnancy, the situation of the time of birth, the child's growth, and information about the vaccination. If pregnancy is founded, please bring the pregnancy notification form distributed by medical institutions and ask for the Maternal and Child Health Handbook.
- When: Weekdays between 8:30 16:30

#### Distribution of the cloth masks

2 cloth masks will be distributed per month if you bring the 'mask receipt', which was distributed with the Maternal and Child Health Handbook or sent in late May, to the health center or the medical insurance. (Limited quantity)

Target: Women during pregnancy

#### Mobile medical service of Tuberculosis roentgen would be conducted

- What: A chest x-ray (Tuberculosis roentgen) examination car would be patrolling in each area.
   Please choose one place by checking the schedule. Medical check-up could be conducted anywhere in Numazu by free.

## leph Cooperation needed for the Population and Housing Census leph

The Population and Housing Census, the most important statistical survey in Japan, will be conducted. In an effort to prevent the spread of the novel coronavirus, the response to the census will be sent either via internet or mail.

The Population and Housing Census will be conducted simultaneously nationwide on October 1<sup>st</sup> 2020 as the date of record. The Census is an important large-scale statistical survey that is implemented based on the Statistics Act aiming at all people and households who reside within the country.

The Census has been conducted every 5 years from 1920 and has reached a significant milestone of 100 years this year.

- ! Watch out for the fraud or any suspicious survey.
- ① Receive the documents: Investigators will distribute the documents from September 14<sup>th</sup> (Mon) by putting it into a mailbox etc.
- ② Methods of response
  - Via Internet: After receiving the documents, visit the Response website and follow directions to complete the survey by October 7<sup>th</sup> (Wed).
  - Via mail: If the above method is not possible, place the completed census paper into the enclosed return envelope and mail it by October 7<sup>th</sup> (Wed).
  - Via investigators: Investigators will visit people or households for those whom either a
    response is not confirmed by the deadline or a prior notice is given that the 2 methods
    above are not workable.
