★ Be aware of the food poisoning! ★

Let's keep the following three principles to prevent food poisoning; "Do not spread, Do not allow to multiply, Destroy".

- 1. Do not spread bacteria
 - Thoroughly wash food, cooking utensils, fingers, etc.
- 2. Do not allow bacteria to multiply
 - Do not leave food at room temperature and put them in the refrigerator to keep them under 10 °C.
- 3. Destroy bacteria
 - Thoroughly heating of food and sterilization of cooking utensils.

Vomiting and diarrhea due to food poisoning are the body's defense reactions. Get medical attention as soon as possible without taking over-the-counter medicines.

Partial subsidies are available for those who need to be re-vaccinated due to bone marrow transplant surgery or other special circumstances where previously administered routine vaccinations are no longer effective.

If applicable, please consult with us before re-vaccinating.

- Eligibility: Residents of the city who have been determined by a doctor to be unable to expect the benefits of routine vaccinations that they have already received due to bone marrow transplant surgery, etc. Individuals must have received routine vaccinations at the legally stipulated intervals and frequencies.
- **Eligible vaccination:** Vaccinations against Class A diseases as defined in the Immunization Law, to be administered before the child reaches 18 years of age.
- *There are age restrictions for the following vaccinations; DTP-IPV-Hib, DPT-IPV, BCG, Hib, and streptococcus pneumoniae immunization.

- What: For students who have difficulty paying their National Pension premiums, the "Special Payment System for students" has been established to postpone the payment of premiums. Please take advantage of this system in preparation for receiving pension benefits in the future.
- Eligibility: Students who have earned 1,280,000 yen or less in the previous year.
- Required Documents: Pension book or basic pension number notification, a copy
 of your student ID (front and back) or certificate of enrollment (original) that shows the period of
 enrollment, and ID of the person coming for the procedure (driver's license, etc.).
- **How to apply:** In person at the Citizens' Division on the 1st floor of City Hall or at each satellite Office by the individual or household member
- *Applications are required each fiscal year.
- *Applications can be made retroactively up to the month two years and one month prior to the time of application.

※ New "Video reporting Function" begins Tuesday, July 1.

The Sunto Izu Fire Department will launch a "video reporting function" to improve the speed and accuracy of emergency response.


The new system allows real time video communication between the caller and



the fire command center during a 119 emergency call, using the caller's smartphone.

It helps command staff more accurately identify the location and assess the situation of disaster, enabling quicker firefighting and emergency response activities. In addition, the system can support appropriate first aid guidance by transmitting instructional videos, such as CPR, from the fire command center to the caller.

We ask for your understanding and cooperation that during a 119 call, command staff may request video transmission if they deem it necessary.

% Check your health with a health checkup. Health Center information

To maintain your health, it is important to understand your own body. Regular medical checkups and vaccinations are key to monitoring your health.

Have you already made an appointment? Let's take a Numazu City Health Checkup!

In early June, "Numazu City Health Checkup Coupons" were sent to women aged 20 or over and men aged 35 or over who live in the city. If you need a reissue due to loss or other reasons, please contact the Health Center.

The health checkup will be carried out until October 31. Since medical facilities are very crowded during the latter half of the checkup period, we recommend that you visit the medical institutions as early as possible.

Take an examination for the hepatitis virus

From July 28 to August 3 is "Liver Week", and July 28 is "Japan Hepatitis Day". Hepatitis is transmitted by virus through blood transfusions, sharing tattoo needles, food, etc. Because symptom are rarely noticeable, early detection and treatment can help prevent the condition from worsening and lead to a complete recovery. Take this opportunity to get checked.

- Who: People over 40 who have never taken the city's hepatitis examination.
 - * People ages 41, 46, 51, 56, 61 in Reiwa 7 fiscal year can take the examination for free.

Check your Ora Health! Periodontal disease check-up

Periodontal disease is the number one cause of tooth loss. Because there aren't noticeable symptoms, there are many cases where treatment is being delayed. Prevention requires daily care and regular checkups. Take this opportunity to check your oral health.
